
Need for Speed

We will look at the proactive changes WP has implemented to become faster and more robust




WordPress Improves its Speed

- WordPress has traditionally been argued as a slow solution by its competitors
- As of mid 2022 WP really got a code base overhaul which made it super fast
- This was triggered mostly by Google's new looming algorithm




Plugins Need to Follow Suit

- Many popular themes and plugins became the bottleneck
- Elementor jumped on board and quickly optimized its speed




The Need for Caching is Paramount



 Powerful Hosting Platforms like Cloudways started releasing additional layers of server caching

Popular Caching Plugins

- WP Rocket is a super powerful premium caching plugin
- It does not necessarily deal well with speed when you are logged in
- W3 Total Cache is another powerful option but more complicated to setup



PHP

- PHP released version 8 which became stable also around mid 2021
- I found a lot of plugins had incorporated their code into PHP 8 as this version dropped many coding conventions and methods that were hogs

Database

 MariaDB became the standard extension of MySql around 2005 and has continued to grow and optimize Database performance whereas MySQL has remained somewhat stagnant




Server Wars?

- Hosts often fight between whether Apache or Nginx is better
- My favourite host, Cloudways uses both
- The best host will win the war moving forward



CDNs do not have to be complicated

- CDNs like Cloudflare offer ways of delivering content faster by hosting it (images, scripts, styles, fonts etc)
- BunnyCDN is a really neat and simple to use CDN
- Another powerful use of a CDN is to distribute these assets geographically




What this all means!

- You can host landing pages quickly without needing third party software
- You can leverage a powerful host and take advantage of SEO locally
- You really do not have to worry about the competition accusing WP of being too slow
